

# Dah Yung Cambridge International Bilingual School Cambridge International Program Lower Secondary (Grade 7-9)



Dah Yung International Bilingual School (DYIBS)'s Cambridge International Program (CIP) is designed to provide a world-class education aligned with the Cambridge International Curriculum, ensuring that students gain essential skills and knowledge in preparation for higher academic levels. The Cambridge Lower Secondary curriculum focuses on English, Mathematics, Science, and offers a flexible framework for other subjects, including Global Perspectives, Foreign Languages, and the Arts.

The main objectives of CIP Lower Secondary are:

- 1. To offer an internationally recognized education framework aligned with global standards.
- 2. To enhance students' critical thinking, problem-solving, and analytical skills.
- 3. To prepare students for the Cambridge IGCSE program at the Upper Secondary level.
- 4. To provide students with an edge in international education and competitive exams.



DYIBS's Lower Secondary CIP consists of the following key subjects:

- English (6 periods per week) & English Literature (2 periods per week)
- Mathematics (4 periods per week)
- Science: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Earth Science (5 periods per week)
- Global Perspectives (2 periods per week)
- Mandarin Chinese (5 periods per week)
- Foreign Languages (e.g. Spanish, Japanese) (2 periods per week)
- Information and Communication Technology (ICT) (1 period per week)
- Art and Design (2 periods per week)
- Physical Education (3 periods per week)
- Wellbeing (1 period per week)

Besides regular quizzes and examinations, CIE uses the following Standardized Assessments:

- Progression Tests: These tests are available for the core subjects (English, Math, Science) to help schools
  monitor students' progress.
- **Checkpoint Exams**: At the end of Lower Secondary (Grade 9), students can take the Cambridge Lower Secondary Checkpoint Exams, which are feedback on students' strengths and weaknesses.

  - Students who have passed the B1 Preliminary, formerly known as Cambridge English: Preliminary (PET), will be eligible
  - Students who have not passed B1 Preliminary can take a placement test to determine eligibility

### **Application Process**

- Step 1: Submit Application and Supporting Documents
  - Application Form
  - Identification (Passport, Health Insurance Card, and/or ARC)
  - Official Transcripts from Previous Two Academic Years (non-DYIBS students only)
- Step 2: Review
- Step 3: Testing
- Step 4: Acceptance Decision
